The individual, or individuals when a tie occurs, will receive a plaque and their name on the plaque at AWCI headquarters.

AWCI award for the highest score on the Certified Clockmaker 21st Century "CC21"

This award will be given to the individual who scores the highest score on the Certified Clockmaker 21st Century test within the fiscal year prior to the awards banquet at the annual convention. The individual, or individuals when a tie occurs, will receive a plaque and their name on the plaque at AWCI headquarter

AWCI award for the highest score on the Certified Master Clockmaker 21st Century “CMC21”
