



**AWCI Membership Committee
Mid-Year Report 2008-2009**

At the suggestion of the Executive Director at the annual meeting last August, we thought it best to follow the numbers of membership starting with the first billing. It was our intent to monitor the membership numbers of the various categories as the dues came in.

Members were billed in October of 2008 and had until December 31, 2008 to send in their dues before being assessed a late fee. In October, a total of 2,565 bills went out. The breakdown is as follows:

Regular members-	2,018
Student members-	48
Senior members-	444
Affiliate chapters-	21
IAB-	24
REC (Industry)	5
REC (non-Industry)	5

One of the REC schools did NOT pay for 2008

The numbers will not be available to me from the membership coordinator until mid February, unfortunately too late for this report.
