



## AWCI Education Committee 2012 Annual Report

### Current Projects:

#### CMW21

The practical component of the CMW21 exam is completed. The theory component is under construction.

Next step will be a pilot of both components.

#### Development of ADVANCED 21 series of courses

These are brand specific / product specific courses with which AWCI assists the Industry to increase the proficiency levels of the independent watch service professionals. An Omega/Swatch course is available for the membership in fall. A Rolex course is currently offered. A third course is in development and will be available in January.

#### School Chronometer Competition

The concept of a competition amongst the watchmaking schools for PR and motivational reasons was explored. Due to the significant difference in curricula between the REC Schools, it was decided not to pursue this particular project.

#### WT Exam Draft

A draft WT exam was composed and is ready for a pilot test.

#### End Consumer Glossary

Upon request from President Thompson the Education Committee started working on a horological glossary. The list of terms has been completed, the definitions will be developed in the coming months.

#### Micromechanics courses for Clockmaker and Watchmaker

Various micromechanics courses were outlined that are suited for clockmakers as well as for watchmakers. They are ready to be offered to the membership in fall.

#### Review of the CW21 exam

After 8 years in operation the CW21 exam will undergo some routine maintenance that will be completed by the end of the calendar year.
