As of the writing of this report, there have been two complaints brought to the attention of the Ethics Committee against two different members of the Institute.

- The first member in question is, according to Executive Director Lubic, a repeat offender who has received several complaints over the past few years regarding the quality of the watch repairs performed as well as the ethical manner in which he deals with his clients. This Committee is currently in the process of applying the Ethics Enforcement Procedures to deal with this matter.
- The second member has allegedly sold customers' horological merchandise that was otherwise entrusted to him for the purposes of repair. As of current, he is under custody and being investigated by the local authorities. This Committee is currently in the process of applying the Ethics Enforcement Procedures to deal with this matter.

Since this committee was newly approved a verdict has not yet been reached on the above-mentioned cases. The outcome of our findings will be communicated to the Board of Directors at the earliest possible convenience.
